Music Knowledge Organiser - Beacon Primary Academy - Year 4

We will use the inter-related dimensions of music to describe and compare different pieces of music.

These are:

Pitch: High and low notes

Duration: Comparing how long and short notes are and listening to rhythms

Dynamics: Loud and quiet

Tempo: The speed of music

Timbre (tarm-bre): Different sounds that can be made, for example, by different instruments

Texture: Different textures in music are created by having different amounts and combinations of instruments.

Structure: How a piece of music is organised, for example, if it repeats, etc.

Notations: How the dots are placed on a musical stave so that people can read music...

Our focus will be on how rhythms are shown through notation.
